

## The Most High and His Son

Here is a sampling of the verses I have found in the Hebrew scriptures (using the King James Version) about the Most High God, or Highest, Yahweh.

**Genesis 14:22** And Abram said to the king of Sodom, I have lift up mine hand unto the Yahweh, the most high God, the possessor of heaven and earth.

**Numbers 24:16** He hath said, which heard the words of God, and knew the knowledge of the most High, *which* saw the vision of the Almighty, falling *into a trance*, but having his eyes open:

**Deuteronomy 32:8** When the most High divided to the nations their inheritance, when he separated the sons of Adam, he set the bounds of the people according to the number of the children of Israel.

**2 Samuel 22:14** Yahweh thundered from heaven, and the most High uttered his voice.

**Psalms 83:18** That *men* may know that thou, whose name alone *is* Yahweh, art the most high over all the earth.

**Daniel 7:22** Until the Ancient of days came, and judgment was given to the saints of the most High; and the time came that the saints possessed the kingdom.

God, the Almighty, Yahweh, the Ancient of Days, the Highest, and the Most High, are all the same person. The words "the Most High" designate the Creator Supreme, the Highest Being in the Universe. That's what the *Most High* means. There are other high ranking beings in the universe, but Yahweh is the *Most High*, or Highest of all of them.

There are also places in the Apostolic scriptures that speak of the Most High. It should go, almost without saying, that the Highest/Most High mentioned in the New Testament is the same Highest/Most High mentioned in the Old Testament. There can only be One Most High. He is higher than all other persons and/or beings.

**Luke 2:14** Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace, good will toward men.

**Luke 6:35** But love ye your enemies, and do good, and lend, hoping for nothing again; and your reward shall be great, and ye shall be the children of the Highest: for he is kind unto the unthankful and *to* the evil.

**Acts 7:48** Howbeit the most High dwelleth not in temples made with hands; as saith the prophet.

When we enter into the Apostolic scriptures, we also find that Yeshua the Messiah is given the designation of *Son* of the Highest/Most High.

**Luke 1:32** He shall be great, and shall be called the Son of the Highest: and the Lord God shall give unto him the throne of his father David:

**Mark 5:7** And cried with a loud voice, and said, What have I to do with thee, Yeshua, thou Son of the most high God? I adjure thee by God, that thou torment me not.

**Luke 8:28** When he saw Yeshua, he cried out, and fell down before him, and with a loud voice said, What have I to do with thee, Yeshua, thou Son of God most high? I beseech thee, torment me not.

In the first chapter above (Luke 1), where Yeshua is called great, and the Son of the Highest, John the baptizer is later called a prophet of the Highest (Luke 1:76). I don't think anyone will have trouble interpreting what that means. John is *a prophet* of Yahweh Most High. It should be just as easy to interpret Luke 1:32; Yeshua is *the Son* of Yahweh Most High. Neither Yochanan (John) or Yeshua are the Most High, but they are a prophet (John) and the Son (Yeshua) of the Highest.

In the other two chapters (Mark 5; Luke 8) we have unclean spirits crying out, making an admission about who Yeshua is. These unclean spirits are demons of darkness that Yeshua has been given authority over, to cast out of people, if he so chooses. These demons believe in one God, according to James 2:19, but they believe Yeshua is the Son of that one Most High God, according to Mark 5:7 and Luke 8:28.

Yeshua is highly exalted. He is the head of every man (1 Corinthians 11:3). He now sits at the right hand of the Father in heaven (Psalm 110:1; Acts 2:32-33). I don't believe you can be at a more exalted position than the right hand of Yahweh, unless you are Yahweh Himself. As a matter of fact, Paul said that when Yahweh puts ALL things under Yeshua's feet, it is just manifest (obvious) that Yahweh is the exception to the ALL things (1 Corinthians 15:27). In other words, Yahweh is not one of the "all things" put under Yeshua's feet. Yahweh stays in His Most High position, but Yeshua is at His right hand, which is the next highest position in the universe.

Yahweh is the Most High. He is the only true God (John 17:3a). Yeshua is great, but he is not the Most High. He is the Son of the Most High (Luke 1:32), the man who was sent by the Most High (John 17:3b).
